The objective of the Honor Society is to honor and recognize students at Waltham for their outstanding academic accomplishments.

The Waltham National Junior Honor Society is open to all students who choose to apply themselves and meet the established criteria in five areas: **scholarship, leadership, service, citizenship, and character**.

Here are the requirements for induction into the Waltham National Junior Honor Society:

1. An Application completed at during the 8th Grade Year. Usually at the start of the second quarter.
2. GPA 10.0-12.0 6th -8th Grades. (High Honor Roll Requirements)
3. Conduct Grade of B or better in all classes.
4. Community Service of 40 hours per school year. (Starting during the 2011-2012 school year) Class of 2012 will need 40 hours; Class of 2013 will need 80 hours.

The students will then be recognized for their accomplishments near the end of the school year in an induction ceremony. They will also be eligible to wear a Black Honor Cord at graduation to signify their membership in the society.

This is a tremendous opportunity for our students to earn recognition for their accomplishments during their time at Waltham Elementary School.
